

Photo resizing using Picnik.com

1. Go to <http://www.picnik.com/>

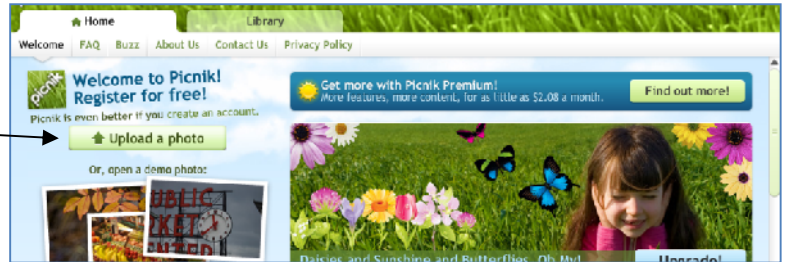
2. Click Get Started Now



(Wait for it to open)

3. Click Upload a photo

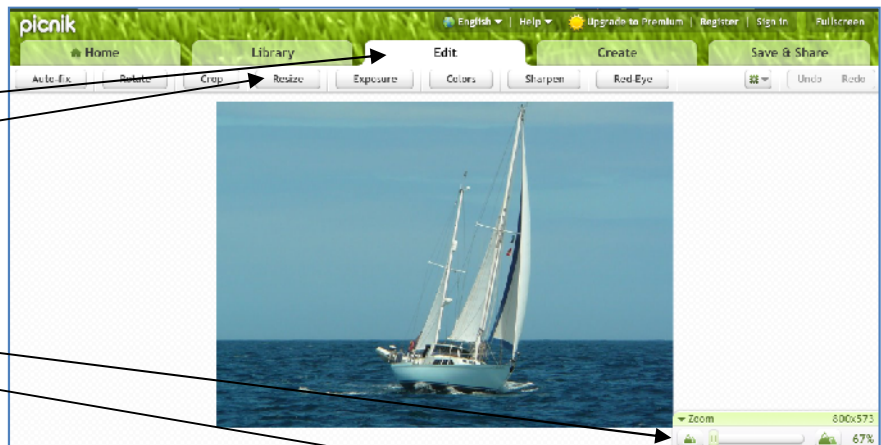
4. A window appears showing files/folders on your computer. Navigate to the picture you want to resize and double click it, or click it and click Open



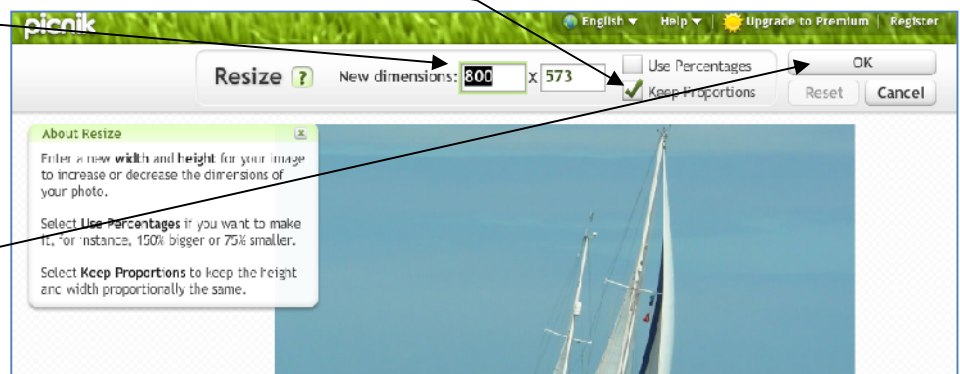
5. Click the Edit tab (if not already there) and click Resize

6. The zoom slider at bottom right controls the size of the picture you see on screen, but makes no difference to the size of the file

7. Make sure Keep Proportions is ticked, enter a new size in one of the New Dimensions boxes, (the other will follow to keep the picture proportions), sizes are in pixels.



When ready, click OK. Typical sizes are:
Large print 1064x768
Large web 640x480
Small web/email 448x336
Thumbnail 160x160



8. Click Save & Share.

9. If you want to keep the original of the photo as well as the reduced size version, type a new file name here.

10. Reduced photo file size is shown here. If it's not what you want click the Edit tab again and change the size.

11. Click Save Photo. You'll see the folder on your computer where you got the original photo. Click Save, or choose another folder and click Save.
